# Certificates in Skills For Life

## What qualifications can you gain from doing Skills for Life courses?

When you feel confident enough you can take a National Test. The National Test measures skills at an equivalent level to other national qualifications.



## How do you achieve the qualification?

The tests comprise of 40 multiple choice questions, which can be taken either on a computer, or as a written paper.
